

Guidelines for abstract/industrial case study submission to the 11th Nordic Wood Biorefinery Conference

Deadline for abstract/industrial case study submission is the 16th of April 2024, 23:59 CET, to abstractsnwbc2024@ri.se

General information

Language: The abstract/industrial case study shall be submitted in English.

Format:

- Use the submission template for abstract/industrial case studies provided on the conference website "NWBC2014_abstact/industrial case study template".
- The abstract has a maximum length of 500 words.
- Please check the abstracts check boxes for abstract/industrial case study submission and if you wish to have an oral or a poster presentation.
- Please indicate in the check box of the template if you are interested in being considered for peer review for publication of the work in a special edition of NWBC24 in Biomass and Bioenergy

Additional information:

- You may submit only one abstract as the first author; however, you may in addition be coauthor of other submitted abstracts.
- Submit your abstract to: abstractsnwbc2024@ri.se
- Abstracts will be reviewed by the NWBC Scientific Committee in a peer review process, with expert reviewers within the specific topics.
- All presentations and posters will be in person, on-site in Örnsköldsvik, Sweden. There is no hybrid version of the conference.
- All presenters are eligible for a discounted conference fee that will be communicated upon confirmation mail of an accepted abstract (oral/poster)
- Student (PhD-students/MSc) presenters are eligible for a further reduced conference fee, Student fee, that will be communicated upon confirmation of an accepted abstract (oral/poster). To apply for a student fee, student presenters are required to also submit a recommendation letter written by their supervisor when submitting their abstract. Recommendation letters are sent to abstractsnwbc2024@ri.se.

Submission timeline and process steps

1 Select a topic within the conference topic list:

- Policy/legislation
- Feedstock
- Side-streams
- Materials
- Bio-based chemicals
- Transporation fuels
- LCA/TEA
- Upscaling
- National and international programmes
- Digitalization/AI technologies

Please note that abstracts/industrial case studies of today's conventional pulping and paper-making processes are outside the scope of NWBC.

2 Use the submission template

Download the Abstracts/industrial case study template available on the conference website.

3 Submission

Check that your submission adheres to the submission guidelines. Submit your contribution via **abst** ractsnwbc2024@ri.se by the 16th of April 2024, 23:59 CET.

4 Review Process

Your submission will undergo review by the NWBC 2024 Scientific Committee.

5 Presentation invitation

If accepted, you will be invited for an oral or visual/poster presentation by the beginning of May 2024. Abstracts that do not fit within NWBC will receive a rejection letter at the same time.

6 Confirm Participation

Confirm your participation as a presenter by the 15th of May 2024 by replying to the invitation to present and registering as a conference participant.

7 Preparation of presentation

Instructions for oral/poster presentations will be sent out to confirmed presenters by the 24th of May 2024.

8 Present at NWBC 2024

Both oral and poster presentations are to be presented in person, during the Nordic Wood Biorefinery Conference on the 15-17th of October 2024. No hybrid version of the conference will be held.

Student award recipients and presenter award recipients will be notified during the conference.

9 Prepare for submission in a special edition of peer review journal

Presenters that applied for submission of their work for a full article in the Special conference edition in Biomass and Bioenergy, <u>Biomass and Bioenergy | Journal | ScienceDirect.com by Elsevier</u>, will by mid-November receive a notification about the status of your request, and the journal editors will provide further instructions.
